Food breaks at school

There are usually 3 food breaks during the school day:

- Fruit break (9.45 10am)
- Morning Tea/Recess (10.45 11.15am)
- Lunch 1.15 2pm

Students need to bring a drink bottle (preferably water) a piece of fruit or vegetable, morning tea and lunch each day. Containers and drink bottles need to be clearly labelled with the students name. Lunch orders can be placed online through Flexischools prior to 9am daily.

The school canteen is open on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday during lunch times for light snacks only. Please note the canteen does not open when it is raining and is run solely by volunteers, if you would like to join the volunteer group please let the school office know so we can direct you to our canteen co-ordinators.

Student absences, late arrivals and early departures

It is essential if your child is absent for a full day that this absence is noted in COMPASS. Any student without a reason for missing school will be recorded with an unexplained absence.

Should students arrive at school late or need to depart school early a parent or carer must sign them/out at the COMPASS Kiosk located in the school office.

When a student is leaving early they remain in their classroom until their parent or carer arrives at the school.

If a student is absent or leaves early and has been booked into after school care it is the parent or carers responsibility to inform OOSH.
